

## **NAEA Subscription Claims Policy**

Updated April 2020

**Note:** You must claim for a missing issue within six months of that issue's delivery date.\* Please include the full title of the journal missing, with the year, volume, and issue number. Also, include your full name, address, and NAEA Member ID / account / order number, if applicable.

- For NAEA members and subscribers within the United States, please allow 4-6 weeks for delivery before submitting a claim for missing issues and all claims must be made within six months of the delivery date for that issue.\*
- For international members and subscribers outside of the U.S., please allow 8-12 weeks for delivery before submitting a claim for missing issues and all claims must be made within six months of the delivery date for that issue.\*

Digital replacements will be supplied to subscribers when no confirmation from the United States Postal Service (USPS) exists that confirms the returned mailing.
